to look at something amazing

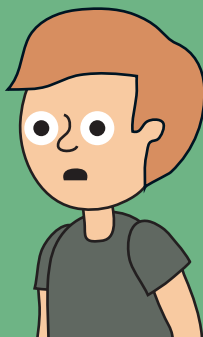
"Feast your eyes on the dessert buffet!"

to catch something without really looking for it

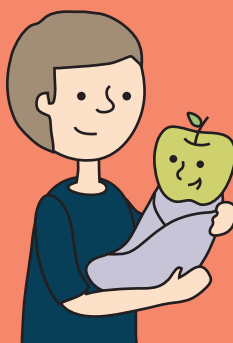
"I spotted a 'For Sale' sign out of the corner of my eye."
